Message from the Commodore

Our Prize Night was the last event to be held in our Clubhouse before its long awaited refurbishment. We are indebted to our sponsor Firmus Energy, and to all those dedicated Club members who made the series possible, particularly Peter Frazer, Aubrey Kincaid and his faithful crew, and Molly Mayrs and her soup team.
