Following the consultation meetings with KPMG Management last December about the proposed establishment of a Lough Neagh Navigation Authority by DCAL, we referred the matter to the RYA NI who, in turn, passed it on to RYA Headquarters in Hamble, who have an Environmental Officer with a national responsibility for such matters. Representatives of the RYA NI Council have had discussions with the Management Consultants, KPMG, and have been assured that they will be involved in any further developments of this proposal and before any final report and recommendations are issued.
