



Message from the Commodore

This is the time for our annual pause in scheduled activities and to summarise our events since the end of the last Winter Series. The **Hop-On-Board** workshops were well supported and created a demand for more formal training in sailing by a growing number of young members, which is a very welcome development. Unfortunately our Regatta was not so well supported but it was nevertheless a thoroughly enjoyable and closely fought series of three races in brisk and variable conditions. Two boats finished with 7 and two with 8 points, with *Eroica* (David King) the proud winner overall, having achieved a first place in the second race. Six of the 7 races in the Summer Series were sailed with *Silver Girl* (Tony Brady) the overall winner and *Eroica* once again picking up the Helmsman's trophy. The Cat's Cradle race was postponed because of lack of wind and will now be sailed in conjunction with the Loughfest Lap-the-Lough race from Kinnego on 22 August. As you know we will be having our Annual Dinner and Prize Night on Saturday 12 September. Further information and tickets will be available at the end of August.



Our social programme has also been very successful and the "Children's Fun Day" (Friday 3 – Saturday 4 July) was particularly enjoyable as evidenced by one of the participants, Laura Crozier, who wrote: ***"---Camping at the Boat Club was one of the best experiences ever!
